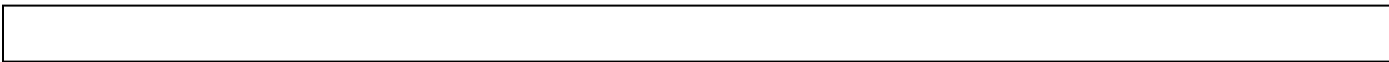

1.0 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

- 1.1 Shawnee State University believes that the right of expression is as necessary as the right of inquiry and that both must be preserved as essential to the pursuit and



- 4.1.2 C . Harassment is defined as unprotected speech that is both:
 - 4.1.2.1 Unwelcome; and
 - 4.1.2.2 So severe, pervasive, and objectively offensive that it effectively activity.
 - 4.1.3 Takes place in a nonpublic forum and is restricted in a way that is reasonable and viewpoint-neutral.
 - 4.1.4 Is subject to content restrictions that are reasonably related to a legitimate pedagogical purpose, including classroom rules enacted by teachers.
 - 4.1.5 Is disruptive to previously scheduled or reserved activities occurring in a public forum.
- 4.2 Nothing within this policy shall be interpreted as preventing the University from restricting speech described in sections 4.1.1, 4.1.2
